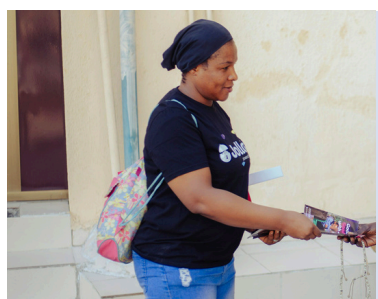

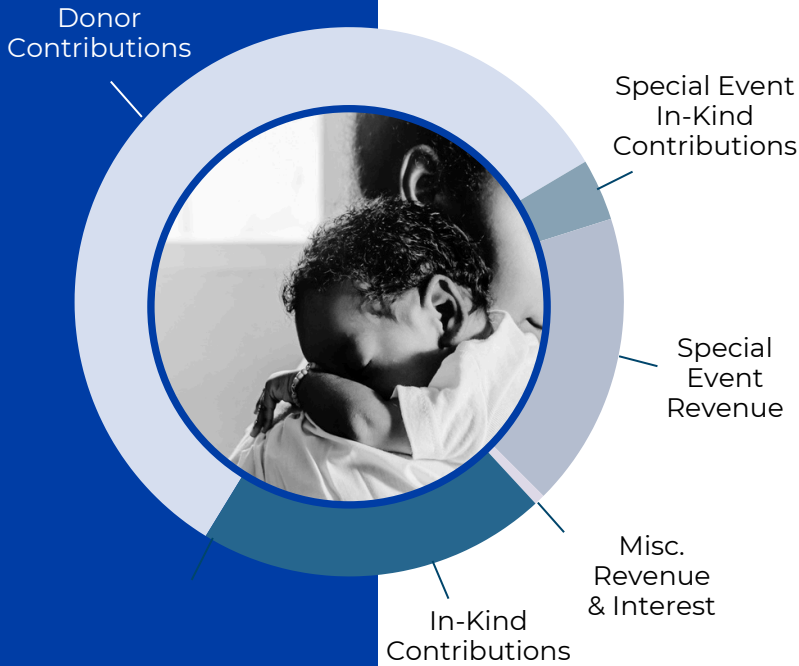

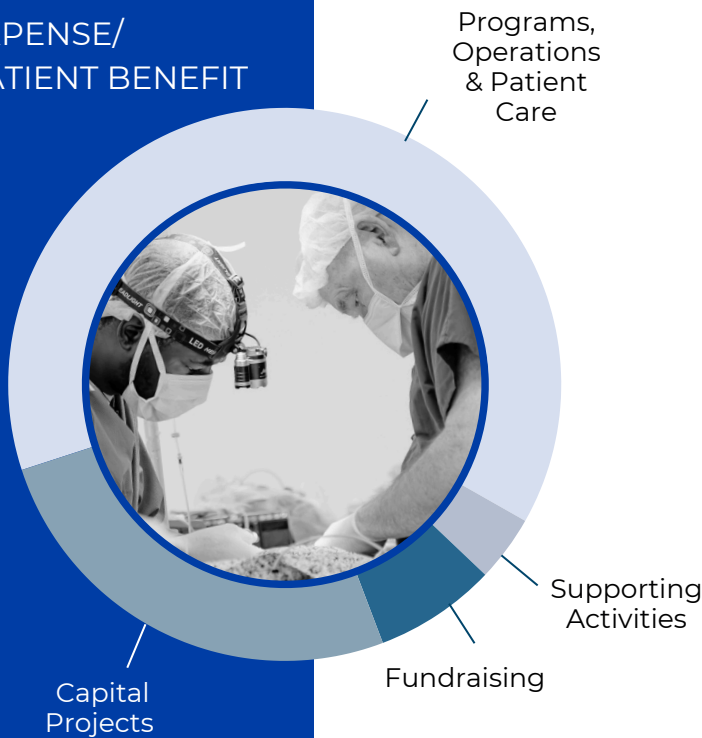
2025 FINANCIAL OVERVIEW

2025: Campus Highlights

Generous donors supported capital improvements to the Surgicenter campus last year as well as education, housing, and scholarship programs. Your generosity has made a lasting difference not only in patient care but in the educational and economic development of Haitian communities.

New Maternity Center

Access to skilled birth care is one of the most effective ways to reduce maternal and newborn deaths in Haiti. The new maternity center will provide exceptional care that supports women and babies in a country where fewer than 40% of births occur in health facilities and maternal mortality is among the highest.

Nursing School Partnership

Thirty second- and third-year students from Nexus College of Nursing in Fonds Parisien are rotating in surgery, maternity, the emergency department, and clinics on our campus. Each department has a nurse coordinator to supervise student clinical education.



Home Building Program

Four homes were built for employees with families. A \$40,000 loan is provided with payback of \$20,000 through a reduction of salary. This allows a family to select the area in Fonds Parisien where they wish to build and live.
